Description: The project brief from the Omani government and the PAEW was to provide a safe and uninterrupted drinking water supply for the city of Muscat that could be operational in the shortest time possible. The authorities also stipulated that the facility should be made mobile for deployment to other locations should an emergency arise. An innovative technique was needed to ensure the government's strict rules on environmental impact and sustainability were also met. The desalination project was required to reach World Health Organisation standards.
